


2020 Census Safety Tips

1. Don't fall prey to phishing scams!
 - Census Bureau **WILL NOT** send unsolicited emails asking you to participate in the census.
 - Census Bureau won't contact you on behalf of a political party.
 - Census Bureau will **NEVER** ask for your Social Security Number, credit card information, or money/donations.
2. Use legitimate census website when answering census survey.
 - <https://www.census.gov>
 - Make sure lock icon  appears in front of the web address.
3. Ask for proper ID from any census worker.
 - Badge with photograph, US Department of Commerce watermark, and expiration date.
 - Call 1-800-923-8282 to question a census worker's identity.
 - Report any suspicious activity to local police department.
4. Verify census information or report any false census information by emailing rumors@census.gov.
