

MINUTES

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

There were no comments from the public.

Chair Elder asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to approve the minutes from April.

MOTION: Motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes from April. Motion approved unanimously.

ASSISTANT TOWNSHIP MANAGER REPORT- Presented by Molly Lum

Old Business

Girls on the Run – The Board of Supervisors agreed with the recommendation provided by the Parks & Rec Board. Girls on the Run were granted approval to use the Lenni Lenape pavilion at no cost.

Family Fishing Event – The Board of Supervisors agreed with the recommendation provided by the Parks & Rec Board. Representative Schlegel will be holding a family fishing event on June 3, 2023, at Lions Lake Park.

New Business

Ebenezer Beautification Committee – The Ebenezer Beautification Committee requested to use the dam breast at the intersection of Jay Street and Route 72 for their Chicken BBQ Fundraiser. It will be held May 17, 2023, from 8AM – 6PM. The Parks & Rec Board only commented on traffic control, which was acknowledged by the committee.

MOTION: Motion was made and seconded to recommend approval for the Ebenezer Beautification Committee to hold their Chicken BBQ Fundraiser on May 17, 2023, below the Lions Lake dam breast. Motion approved unanimously.

Bench Installation Request – A Township resident requested a bench be installed next to a tree she previously purchased and dedicated to her late husband at Community Park. She acknowledged she would pay the \$500.00 fee and sign the agreement. Dave Leid, Parks & Rec Foreman, verified he is okay with this installation.

MOTION: Motion was made and seconded to recommend approval of the bench installation at Community Park. Motion approved unanimously.

A memo will be prepared on behalf of the Parks & Rec Board with their recommendations to be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors for their approval.

All members were provided with Dave Leid’s activity report for the month of April.

COMMENTS FROM BOARD MEMBERS

Corey stated he recently saw another advertisement sign at Lions Lake Park. Our parks are to be a neutral area. Molly agreed and stated we do not allow any signs within our parks except our own. She will ask Dave to remove the signs.

Ryan asked if we still use Border Patrol to help maintain the geese population at Lions Lake. Molly responded yes. Corey requested to be updated with these reports.
