COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Travis Zimmerman – Disc Golf Fundraiser Event May 27, 2024 – Travis attended the meeting on behalf of the Weaverland Conference regarding a disc golf fundraiser they would like to hold at Lenni Lenape Park. All proceeds would go to their church, a non-profit organization. The event will be held from 9 AM – 3 PM. He is not anticipating more than 40 teams, totaling 80 people to participate in the tournament.

MOTION: Motion was made by Corey and seconded by Mark to recommend approval for the request from Travis Zimmerman to hold a disc golf fundraiser at Lenni Lenape Park. Motion approved unanimously.

A memo will be prepared on behalf of the Parks & Rec Board with their recommendations to be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors for their approval.

Old Business

Girls on the Run / Union Canal Elementary – Lenni Lenape 4/24/24 – The Board of Supervisors agreed with the recommendation provided by the Parks & Rec Board. Girls on the Run did use Lenni Lenape Park for their practice 5k.

Lebanon County Disc Golf – The Board of Supervisors agreed with the recommendation provided by the Parks & Rec Board. Lebanon County Disc Golf has permission to complete upgrades to the disc golf course. The league will send our sponsorship letters, but the Township will collect the funds. This is how the sponsorship money was handled when the course was first installed.

Tree Dedication Agreements – The Board of Supervisors agreed with the recommendation provided by the Parks & Rec Board. Two (2) trees located at Lenni Lenape Park have been dedicated. The plaques have been installed.

PARKS & REC ACTIVITIES - All members were provided with Dave Leid’s activity report for April.

COMMENTS FROM BOARD MEMBERS

Corey asked Supervisor Heisey if the Township was still pursuing the idea of a dog park. Supervisor Heisey stated conversations are still occurring, but the initial proposal would need to be scaled down.
