**Old Business**

**Diamond Tex** – Chair Elder asked about possible funding from The Township on maintenance on 2 (two) baseball infields located at the Community Park. He would like to do this in the Fall 2024. Uhrich is going to obtain a quote on the approximate cost for this project, while Amber looks at other options. Recommendation for The Township to make an investment in the baseball fields was made.
