**COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC**

**Old Business**

**Diamond Tex** –The Township agreed to purchase Diamond Tex for the 2 (two) baseball infields located at the Community Park for the Baseball Association. Funds were budgeted for this.

**New Business**

**Lion’s lake Restoration Update** – The lake will start to be drawn down at the end of August in preparation for the restoration project which is anticipated to begin this fall.

Long Lane Parking Lot – Concerns about ground maintenance and overnight parking at the Water Street lot were addressed.

Township Park Pavilion Rentals- The rules and regulations for pavilion rentals at all Township Parks was revised to highlight important language. Upon the board’s approval, new revised signs may be posted at the parks.

**MOTION:** Motion was made by Corey and seconded by Audrey to recommend all Township Parks be completely smoke free to the public and posted on signs and Township Park documents. Motion approved unanimously.

**MOTION:** Motion was made by Corey and seconded by Mark to recommend placing signage at the Lion’s Lake Dam Breast stating, “No Fishing off the Dam Breast”, pending there are currently no signs in place. Motion approved unanimously.

Little League Baseball Shed- The League was offered a 20 x 20 vinyl garage shed and asked if this could be placed at the Township Community Park stoned parking lot off N 8<sup>th</sup> Ave.

**MOTION:** Motion was made by Corey and seconded by Mark to recommend the Board of Supervisors approve the placement of the new shed at the Township Community Park stoned parking lot. Motion approved unanimously.

**PARKS & REC ACTIVITIES** - All members were provided with Dave Leid’s activity report for July.
