**ORDINANCE NO. 6 – 2024**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF NORTH LEBANON TOWNSHIP, PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 15 – MOTOR VEHICLES, PART 4. GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTION 15-403. PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS.**

WHEREAS, North Lebanon Township has issued a driveway permit to New Covenant Christian School to allow the installation of a driveway with ingress/egress onto Long Lane; and

WHEREAS, the installation of the driveway necessitates that adequate sight distance be maintained to the east and west of the driveway along Long Lane; and

WHEREAS, safe ingress and egress using the driveway access to Long Lane from New Covenant Christian School requires areas of no parking to be implemented along the south side of Long Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of North Lebanon Township has deemed it necessary to amend the Code of Ordinances of North Lebanon Township to reflect an area of prohibited parking along the south side of Long Lane.

WHEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of North Lebanon Township, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, that the following amendments shall be made to the Code of Ordinances of North Lebanon Township:

**Section 1.** Chapter 15 – Motor Vehicles, Part 4. General Parking Regulations, § 15-403. Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations, Paragraph 1, Public Thoroughfares shall be amended to include the following areas of no parking:

<b>Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Between</b>
Long Lane	South	Starting 655 feet west of Water Street and continuing for a distance of 295 feet west

**Section 2.** Any ordinance or resolution or part of ordinances or resolutions conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** If any article, section, subsection, provision, regulation, limitation, restriction, sentence, clause, phrase or word in this Ordinance, is, for any reason declared to be illegal, unconstitutional or invalid, by any Court of competent jurisdiction, this decision shall not affect or impair the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any other article, section, subsection, provision, regulation, limitation, restriction, sentence, clause, phrase, word, or remaining portion of the within Ordinance. The Board of Supervisors of North Lebanon Township, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, hereby declares that it would have adopted the within Ordinance and each article, section, subsection, provision, regulation, limitation, restriction, sentence, clause, phrase and word thereof, irrespective of the limitations, restrictions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or word that may be declared illegal, unconstitutional or invalid.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption.
