



**Dam Breast Signage Update** – The Township ordered two (2) additional signs that were installed on October 25, 2024. One of these signs was placed at the top right of the dam breast closest to Jay Street, while the other sign is posted on the top left of the dam breast near Perry Street. Both signs read “Stay Off Rocks and No Trespassing”.

**New Business**

**Ebenezer Dam Inspection** – Inspection was completed on September 30, 2024, with no noted concerns. All members were provided with the inspection checklist report.

**Little League Field Agreement** – The Board agreed to table this discussion until next month’s meeting when Chair Elder is in attendance.

**Tree Dedication Agreement** – One (1) tree located at township Community Park was selected for a tree dedication. Agreements have been signed and fees have been paid. Amber asked for a recommendation to accept the new tree dedication.

MOTION: Motion was made by Ryan and seconded by Corey to recommend approval to the Board of Supervisors for the tree dedication agreement for a tree at the Township Community Park. Motion approved unanimously.

**Jay Street Wall Grant** – The Township was awarded \$300,000 from the LSA grant. This is a state grant provided from the PA Gambling Act from casino revenue. These funds will help with repairing the 315-foot retaining wall along Jay Street, paving and installation of protective fencing. There is no set date for when this project would begin at this time, as it will have to be placed out for bids.

**PARKS & REC ACTIVITIES** - All members were provided with Dave Leid’s activity report for October. Amber also noted we are planning on closing the park bathrooms at the end of November along with keeping an eye on the weather in the meantime.
