## DEFINITIONS

"Authority" or "NLTMA" shall mean North Lebanon Township Municipal Authority.

"Equivalent Dwelling Unit" (EDU) with regard to residential owner, is any room, group of rooms, house trailor, mobile home, enclosure, etc., occupied or intended for occupancy as separate living quarters for a family or other group of persons living together or by persons living alone. For Industrial and Commercial users an EDU shall be determined by the schedule of EDU's as adopted by Resolution of the Authority or shall be determined by the Authority based on other information.

"Township" shall mean Township of North Lebanon.

"Owner" or "Person" shall mean any individual, partnership, company, association, society, trust, corporation or other group or entity.

  - a. Less than 250 EDU's in the development
  - b. No public pump stations or force mains are needed
  - c. Gravity sewer sizes will generally not exceed 8" in diameter
  - d. The project will not cause a Chapter 94 overload of the collection system for 5 years from the date of application

Note: If any of the above conditions cannot be met, a Component 3 Planning Module will be required to be processed.

### **Designated Municipal Official** E.

I. The Township Manager or Chairman of the Board of Supervisors shall be designated as the municipal official who shall sign the postcard mailer and return to DEP/DLA.

## TAPPING FEES

### Sewer Treatment Capacity and Tapping Fees Α.

Each owner shall be required to first purchase sewer treatment capacity at the CoLA Treatment Plant by making application to the NLTMA and paying the sewer treatment capacity fee and the NLTMA tapping fee. The number of EDU's required to be purchased shall be according to the EDU chart that is adopted by the NLTMA Board, or in special cases, by agreement. The sewer treatment capacity fee may change at the discretion of CoLA and the owner will be charged accordingly. No sewer treatment capacity shall be guaranteed until such time as sewer treatment capacity at the CoLA Treatment Plant is granted. The NLTMA tapping fee is calculated by the Authority Engineer as set forth in Resolution 02-2005. This is for collection and capacity within NLTMA's lines.

- **New Connections** I.
  - a. Capacity
  - b. Tapping Fee

Existing customers who are adding new buildings/expansions will be required to purchase additional sewer treatment capacity at the CoLA Treatment Plant by application through NLTMA and to pay additional NLTMA tapping fees. The number of EDU's shall be determined by the CoLA EDU chart.

- Existing Customers Adding New Buildings or Expansions Π.

NLTMA will monitor the usage for a period of one year. If at the end of that year the data shows that the customer is using more EDU's than purchased, the customer will have the opportunity to reduce the usage within the next 12 months, or the customer will be required to purchase additional sewer treatment capacity and tapping fees per EDU.

### **Time of Payment** В.

The capacity fee for sewer treatment shall be paid prior to final plan approval. The tapping fee shall be paid at the time of application for the sewer permit.

### Special Purpose Tapping Fee I (Water Street) с.

This tapping fee shall be applicable only to those sewer customers who connect to the "NLTMA Sewer System" within the area as outlined in tables included in Resolution 2-1998. This shall be paid at the time of application for the sewer permit.

### Special Purpose Tapping Fee II (Long Lane) D.

This tapping fee shall be applicable only to those sewer customers who connect to the "NLTMA Sewer System" within the area as outlined in Table WS-4 included in Resolution 05-2000. This shall be paid at the time of application for the sewer permit.

### Special Purpose Tapping Fee IV (N 8th Avenue) Ε.



### G. Reimbursement

The Developer shall be entitled to reimbursement under the Municipality Authorities Act from any future connections made within ten (10) years outside of the development to any sewer and water (Township water service area only) line constructed by the Developer at his expense and subsequently dedicated to the Authority. The Authority and Developer shall enter into a Reimbursement Agreement in accordance with Section 5607(d)(31) of the Pennsylvania Municipality Authorities Act.
