OPEN BURNING PROHIBITED IN ALL R1 & R2 DISTRICTS

Ord 1-2016 Effective 10/17/2026

**1. Containers must be non-combustible
& Covered with a 1/4" screen.**
(see example photo below)

**2. Fires must be 30 feet from any
structure and must be attended at all
times.**

**3. Burning must be done between the
hours of 7am and sunset.**

**Burning is NOT ALLOWED on Sundays,
Mondays and the following Holidays:**

New Year's Day	Memorial Day
July 4 th	Labor Day
Thanksgiving Day	Christmas Day

Burning Regulations for North Lebanon Township

What can be burned?



The following items can be burned in **PERMITTED AREAS** only

1. Scrap Paper

Such as paper towels, paper plates, napkins & tissues.

2. Paper Board

Such as soda cartons, cereal boxes and pasta boxes.

Burning of recyclables is NOT ALLOWED

This includes corrugated cardboard boxes, brush, leaves or any construction materials.



Burn Bans

WHEN A BURN BAN IS IN PLACE:

When extremely dry conditions are present due to lack of rain, the Lebanon County Commissioners or NLT Board of Supervisors may issue a burn ban until said conditions are more favorable for burning.



FINES



Residents who are burning illegally may be fined up to **\$1000**. To report any illegal burning activities, please reach out to the Lebanon County Regional Police Dept. (717) 273-8141 or by calling EMA Dispatch after hours (717) 272-2054

Recreational Burning

Outdoor fires are permitted for recreational purposes within the Township. Compliance with Ord 1-2016 is required.

The following rules apply:



1. Only dry, aged wood and sticks may be burned.
2. Fires are restricted to 3 foot in diameter and must not produce dense smoke.
3. Designated place for the fire must be at least 30 feet from any building or structure.
4. The fire must be attended at all times by a responsible adult.
