
Hello Spring, We've Missed You!

As the temperatures begin to rise, keep these helpful tips in mind to ensure an enjoyable spring season.

- Get active & outdoors with walking, biking, hiking or gardening.
- Eat fresh seasonal fruits and veggies.
- Inspect & service all lawn tools before use.
- Keep your property maintained as grass & weeds begin to grow.
- Stay hydrated, especially with increased activity.
- Protect eyes and skin from excessive UV exposure.
- Service your HVAC systems.
- Clear roof & gutters of debris.

NLT **ONLY** ACCEPTS: Cash, Check, or Money Orders.
NO DEBIT OR CREDIT CARDS will be accepted in the office!



SPRING CLEANUP ****ALL items must be curbside by 6:00am April 13th***

Only **ONE** sweep of the Township will be made.

Spring clean up is for **BRANCHES, STICKS & TWIGS ONLY!** All branches must be cut to **6 foot in length or smaller** and be **less than 6 inches in diameter**. Place in **neat 6 foot to 8 foot long piles PARALLEL to the curb**. Piles may be as high as 4 feet.

Any items placed in open barrels or bins will be collected and the receptacles will be left on the curb. Please **DO NOT** include root systems or sod of any kind. Any unacceptable items will be left on the property and will be the owners' responsibility to discard. The Township **will not** drive down private lanes/alleys to pick up material. All material must be brought to the end of the lane/alley to be accessible for pick up from the nearest street. Please keep piles away from obstructions such as poles, mailboxes, cars, etc. The Yard Waste Facility is available for those who miss the collection and have a Yard Waste Access Card.

Yardwaste Card

To purchase a Yard Waste Access Card, stop by the Township Office any time during our regular office hours. The fee is \$50 and is valid for the calendar year. Enjoy perks such as all you can scoop mulch and access to the yard waste disposal areas year round.

MOSQUITO PREVENTION



Follow these three simple and natural steps to reduce your risk of mosquito bites this season:

1. Eliminate all standing water on your property that could be breeding mosquitoes.
2. Wear loose-fitting, long clothing that covers the skin when spending time outdoors.
3. Use essential oils known for their mosquito repellent properties such as peppermint, lemongrass, citronella, rosemary and cedarwood.

There's been an increase in stolen vehicles being sold on platforms like Facebook Marketplace using fake titles and altered paperwork. To keep yourself safe, confirm the VIN and review a full history report. Avoid cash-only deals and meet sellers in public places. Look for signs of tampering, and never buy without proper ownership documents. If anything seems wrong, trust your gut. Staying alert can help you avoid trouble.

TIRES MUST BE OFF THE RIM, DRAINED OF WATER, UNBURNED, AND NOT EXCESSIVELY DIRTY.

PAVING/OIL & CHIP

Spring brings warm weather and work crews. Please use caution while traveling and observe signs, flaggers, and workers on the roads. This year's paving projects include:

- **Paving Heffelfinger Road**
(from Morrissey Drive to Route 343)
- **Paving Morrissey Drive**
(from Mt. Zion Road to Township line)
- **Oil & Chip on Halfway Drive**
(from Route 422 to the Township line)
- **Oil & Chip Emma Road**
(from Elias Avenue to the Township line)

Some preliminary work will be done prior to the start of the paving. Expect delays, especially during peak travel times. Stay alert and drive with caution. HELP keep our workers SAFE!

TOILETS ARE NOT TRASHCANS™



Flushable wipes are not truly flushable. They stay whole in the sewer system and block pumps and pipes. These blockages can cause spills in the community and lead to expensive repairs. Please help keep our system safe by flushing only toilet paper and throwing all other items in the trash.

MOWING & STORM WATER MANAGEMENT

Township ordinances prohibit the disposing of grass clippings in nearby storm water inlets, swales and basins. **Blowing grass into the street is also prohibited.** Grass that is blown into the street ultimately ends up in the storm sewers and pollutes our creeks and rivers. **Any such activity is a violation of Township ordinances and subject to fines and penalties.**



Do your part by reporting any spills, illicit discharges, or suspicious dumping into storm drains to your local municipality. Clogged storm drains can lead to flooded roadways & properties.



GONE WITH THE WIND...

Windy days can scatter loose items fast. The Township ordinance requires owners or tenants to keep all garbage and recycling inside containers at all times and to clean up anything that blows out. Keep lids tight and weigh them down so nothing escapes. Your items stay your responsibility until your hauler picks them up. Help keep streets, drains, and nearby yards free of litter.

- Sewer Bills Sent 5/10 - Sewer Bills Due 6/10
- Sewer Bills Sent 8/10 - Sewer Bills Due 9/10
- Sewer Bills Sent 11/10 - Sewer Bills Due 12/10

Mail or drop off payments at the Township Office using **CASH, CHECK, or MONEY ORDER**. Post-dated checks will **NOT** be accepted and will be returned by mail. Card payments are **NOT** accepted in the office.

To have your payment applied immediately, use our online portal by logging on to <https://northlebanon.authoritypay.com>. Your **ACCOUNT NUMBER** and **CID NUMBER** (found on your bill) are required. **Auto Pay** is also available online. Payments process on the due date. Credit cards can be used online only.
