

MINUTES

March 3, 2026

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: There were no comments from the public.

MEETING MINUTES from February 3, 2026, are ready for action. Vice Chair Uhrich asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to approve the minutes from February.

Old Business

Tree Dedication – Community Park – The Board of Supervisors approved the tree dedication request for Virginia Noll, for one tree.

Northern Lebanon Little League – Portable Toilet Request – The Board of Supervisors approved the request for portable toilets to be placed at both the Township and Lions Lake baseball fields at the leagues expense.

Community Park – Donation – The Board of Supervisors thanked the family for the donation of a microwave oven to be placed at the full-service pavilion. The family has been notified, and they have already delivered the item to the Township. Dave Lied will be building a shelf to support the microwave oven.

New Business

2026 Trout Season – Lions Lake was re-stocked with Rainbow Trout on March 2nd at 11am by the Huntsdale Hatchery from Carlisle PA. In addition, Youth Trout Day is scheduled for Saturday March

28th. This is a statewide event for youth 16 years and younger. Lions Lake restrooms will be opened for this event.

J-Rock Volunteer – Each year, the volunteer team from Lebanon Area Evangelical Free Church reaches out to the Township about potential opportunities for service within our community. The scheduled dates for the event are from Friday May 1st through Sunday May 3rd. We continue to prepare a list of projects the group can assist the Township with.

Lions Lake - Live Stakes – During the first week of March there will be warranty work taking place on the previously planted live stakes around Lions Lake. Contractor Flyway Excavating who performed the lake restoration project will be planting a new type of live stake species to replace the species that didn't survive. During this process, the lake will be lowered to 1 foot below the normal level so the crew can perform the work.

Disc Golf at Leni Lenape Park – Upgrades Occurring – During the upcoming months there will be several upgrades happening to the Disc Golf course at Leni Lenape Park. The list includes a newly created course map that will be hung outside the restrooms. Moving the lost disc box from tee 1 next to the map near the restrooms. Replacing old tee signs with new ones which the league purchased with their sponsorship donation funds. For anyone interested, there are 4 tournaments currently scheduled for the upcoming season. Dates scheduled are April 11th, April 12th, April 25th and July 11th.

EUC Soccer Club – New President –Ebenezer/ Union Canal Soccer Club has a new president for 2026, it is now Cassandra Bixler. She was informed the club needs to sign their yearly lease agreement and provide the Township with proof of liability insurance prior to accessing the fields.

Ebenezer Dam Inspection – Inspection was completed on March 2, 2026. Nothing out of the ordinary to note, just some vegetation growth that needs trimming.

PARKS & REC ACTIVITIES - All members were provided with Dave Leid's activity report for February.

With there being no more business brought before the Parks and Recreation Board, the meeting was adjourned at 7:06 P.M.
