

MINUTES
NORTH LEBANON TOWNSHIP
PARKS & RECREATION BOARD
June 2, 2026

The regularly scheduled meeting of the North Lebanon Township Parks & Recreation Board was called to order at 7:00 PM by Vice Chair Uhrich at the North Lebanon Township Municipal Building located at 725 Kimmerlings Road, Lebanon PA. Also in attendance were Recording Secretary, Brandi Trumbo, Township Resident, Jim Cikovic, and members of the Lebanon County Suicide Prevention Task Force, Skyler Dietrick and Monica Boyer.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:

Skyler Dietrick and Monica Boyer from the Lebanon County Suicide Prevention Task Force were present to ask permission to relocate their remembrance garden from Stoevers Dam Park to Lion's Lake Park. This is their 10-year anniversary and they are planning a "walk" event the last Saturday in September to honor the anniversary. They want to provide a reflection area for families to visit. They hope to include a bench, planter, garden flag, and a display case.

MOTION was made by Mark and seconded by Ryan to make a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors to approve the request to create an area for a memorial garden at Lion's Lake. Motion approved unanimously.

MEETING MINUTES from May 5, 2026, are ready for action. Vice Chair Uhrich asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the May meeting.

Old Business

Mobile Food Vendors/Trucks update – Last month the Parks & Recreation Board recommended the Supervisors look at revising the Parks & Recreation regulations to allow the use of food trucks in the Township. Your comments and suggestions were provided to the Supervisors, and they authorized Solicitor Leonard to prepare an ordinance and regulations for the use of mobile food vendors/trucks within our Township and Township property. Once a draft is completed it will be provided for your review and comments.

Keystone Fireworks Payment Received – A few months ago, it was reported that the Township had received their liability insurance, while their payment remained outstanding. We have officially received their payment. They will set up the tent in the middle of June and will tear down by the middle of July.

New Business

New Plans/FILO – None to report.

Northern Lebanon Little League – Thank you – Last month the Township received a phone call from a representative from the Northern Lebanon Little League. They were scheduled to have their teams and the boys' individual photos taken on April 25th, however, the weather did not cooperate. They asked if they could use the rental pavilion so they wouldn't have to reschedule due to rain. As it was early in the season and the pavilion rentals have not yet begun, the Township allowed them to use the pavilion free of charge. They were very thankful and subsequently sent the Township a check in the amount of \$100 as a donation for our generosity.

VF Corp Volunteers – Thank you – The Board extends its thanks to Tammy Quirk and a group of managers and supervisors from VF Corp in Jonestown who volunteered their time on Friday, May 29th at the Township Community Park. They mulched around the trees and the playground and wiped down the picnic tables at the full-service pavilion. The Township appreciates their time and the work they put in to help keep our parks looking beautiful.

WellSpan Health – Go Lebanon – Rebekah Hammer with WellSpan, reached out with an update on the GO Lebanon program. They have placed their "GO" posts at Lenni Lenape and the Township Community Park. The program officially opened on June 1st and will run through August 15th. Upon completion, they will retrieve their posts no later than Tuesday, August 18th. Flyers have been hung in the Township office to help make residents aware of this fun outdoor program.

PARKS & REC ACTIVITIES - All members were provided with Dave Leid's activity report for May.

With there being no more business brought before the Parks and Recreation Board, the meeting was adjourned at 7:21 P.M.
